## Goal of TLEPN: Reduce the number of Police Suicide to ZERO



Statewide program designed to give every Texas law enforcement officer access to specially trained peers to address stressors, trauma, fatigue, and other needs to combat workforce burnout and END POLICE SUICIDE.



What is the Texas Law Enforcement Peer Network?

Statewide network of peers, trained by TLEPN, with TCOLE Approved Curriculum

Connects peace officers, telecommunicators, corrections officers across the State of Texas and guidance to culturally competent MHP

Maintains a resource list of certified culturally competent mental health providers vetted by experts

Family and peer events hosted by law enforcement agencies

Respond to Crises by contacting lead agency to offer statewide resources, Peer Support, Chaplains, MHP, and other support















The Importance of Early Intervention
